



Consent to be contacted for scientific studies at the Max Planck Institute for Human Development

Purpose of data processing

The Max Planck Institute for Human Development (MPIB) is always looking for people to participate in our research. With this consent form, you agree that we may contact you for future studies.

This does not oblige you to participate in a specific study. If you should take part in a specific study, you will be required to provide us with separate study consent. You can always refuse to participate in a study without giving reasons.

This consent form is optional. You can also participate in a single study without being contacted for future studies.

What information about you will be stored?

Only your name and at least one contact option (address, e-mail or telephone number) are required to be stored in our contact database. All other information is optional. These are in particular characteristics that enable us to decide whether you are eligible for a particular study. This may also include information about whether you are not eligible for certain types of studies or are not interested in them. However, no details of the reasons are stored.

In addition, we record the date of entry into the database, the date of the last contact and a copy of your consent form.

- Contact information allows us to contact you.
 - o First name, surname, academic title
 - Date of birth
 - Gender
 - Street, house number, postcode, city
 - o E-mail address, phone number
 - Availability (temporary absence)
 - Contact details of legal representatives, if applicable
- Optional: The following information will help us decide whether you are suitable for a study.
 - Age
 - o Gender
 - Mother tongue
 - German language skills
 - Highest school qualification
 - Handedness
 - Geo-coordinates (derived from address)
 - Previous participation in studies (e.g. to avoid repetition of experiments or to be able to invite you to follow-up studies)
 - o Information about whether you are not eligible for or interested in certain types of studies. However, no details of the reasons will be stored.

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- Other information
 - Date of entry into the database
 - Date of last contact
 - Copy of this consent form
 - Source of data (e.g. contact form on the website, flyer)

Data transfer

Your data will only be processed within the MPIB and by the above-mentioned service providers and will not be passed on to other external parties.

Retention period

The data will be kept until you withdraw your consent.

How will my data be stored and processed?

The MPIB maintains and operates a participant database. Only authorised staff can read or edit your data. If you take part in scientific studies, the data collected in the studies will be stored separately and outside of the participant database. It will only be linked to your name by a pseudonym. The handling of study data is described in detail in a separate consent form for study participation.

Your rights

- You have the right to know what data we hold about you.
- You have the right to correct, delete or restrict the processing of your data. Please note

 which scientific data belong to you. Accordingly, we will no longer be able to provide you
 with information about this data.
